1. All retainers are non-refundable. Events cancelled within 180 days of an event date will be subject to a 50% cancellation fee (50% of the remaining balance). Events cancelled within 120 days of an event are subject to a 100% cancellation fee.
2. The Customer shall pay the Contractor for its services one week prior to date of the event by cash, check or money order. Checks or money orders should be made payable to: Dave Dionne or Dionne Entertainment
3. Additional Hours: \$150 each.
4. It is agreed that the Contractor is an independent Contractor and is not an employee of the Customer.
5. The Contractor shall at all times have complete supervision, direction and control over the services of its personnel on this engagement.
6. In the event that the Contractor is unable to perform, the Contractor will provide a replacement at no charge for the event described. In addition, as liquidated damages, the Customer will be refunded 50% of the total agreed price.
